Community Program Director

The Community Program Director is a unique opportunity for a well-qualified person with youth program experience to join a team and to effectively guide young people in Philadelphia schools and communities. Working predominantly with 1) elementary and middle school students (K-8th grade) and 2) members of our partner school communities, the candidate's primary responsibilities are to engage and recruit students from our partner schools, support our year-round education programs, and assist the team in expanding our community services as a Community Access Network site for US Squash. The individual will work in tandem with the Middle School Academic and Squash Directors to engage and recruit cohorts of 40-50 students who are chosen from School District of Philadelphia (SDoP) partner schools in North Philadelphia's Hunting Park and West Philadelphia's Mantua Promise area. The individual will collaborate closely with the full program staff to ensure strong relations with all students, school personnel, and community members; recruit new students annually; manage relationships with gym and community personnel at core schools, and help build programs to be delivered through the Lenfest Center Community Access opportunities; as well as track student recruitment leads via SalesForce.

Candidates with fluency in Spanish will be given strong preference. Candidates also should have strong speaking, writing, presentation, and interpersonal skills and hold a BA/BS or have equivalent work experience. Interdisciplinary skills or coursework in youth programming or community-based organization experiences are a plus. Hours of employment are full-time, with weekly schedules based on school visits/in-school sessions per the school schedule and needs of SquashSmarts community programming, not to exceed 40 hours. Additional events throughout the year will require participation beyond regular expected hours.

Specific Responsibilities:

- 1. Design and lead weekday gym and recruitment sessions in partner schools
- 2. Support cohort leads in creating comprehensive recruitment plan
- 3. With cohort leads, implement and manage relationships between school partners, families, and program;
- 4. Maintain recruitment lead records on SalesForce to monitor conversion to core program
- 5. Communicate and meet frequently with partner school teachers and community liaisons
- 6. Create and organize on-site SquashSmarts field trips for partner school students as part of recruitment efforts
- 7. Recruit community members to serve as volunteer tutors
- 8. Assist Director of Community Support with building up community offerings through new community access network site

Assist With The Following:

- 1. Program-wide recruitment, retention and relations with all students and alumni
- 2. Provide information relevant to lead to student conversion and other community initiatives
- 3. Prepare reports and updates for website, email and other printed materials on community initiatives as needed
- 4. Assist with special networking and fundraising events
- 5. Assist with chaperoning SquashSmarts' events (tournaments, service events, etc)
