Director of Middle School Academics

The Director of Middle School Academics is a unique opportunity for a well-qualified man or woman with classroom management experience to join a team and to effectively guide young people from under resourced schools and communities. Primary responsibility is to engage and mentor students through our year-round middle school education program. The individual will work in tandem with the Director of Middle School Squash & Fitness to engage and instruct a cohort of 30 students per grade in 6th, 7th and 8th grade that are recruited from School District of Philadelphia (SDoP) partner schools in North Philadelphia's Hunting Park. The individual will collaborate closely with the full program staff to ensure strong relations with all students, families, volunteers and partners; recruit new students annually; creatively design and deliver an intentional academic curriculum focusing on core skills; manage high school placement; and track student progress via the organization's student metric and evaluation system.

Candidates should have strong speaking, writing, presentation, and interpersonal skills and hold a BA/BS or equivalent international degree. Spanish-speaking candidates will be given strong preference. Interdisciplinary skills or course work in education, childhood development, social work, education or psychology are a plus. Typical weekly hours of employment are (September-June) Monday through Thursday 10:00am-6:30pm and either Friday 12:00pm-6:00pm or Saturday 9:00am-3:00pm; and (July-August) Monday through Friday 9:00am-4:00pm. Additional events throughout the year will require participation beyond regular expected hours.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Design and lead weekday/weekend academic tutoring sessions focusing on homework help but also including non-homework based reading, writing, organization and interpersonal skill instruction;
2. Design, implement and manage the program's year-round academic calendar;
3. Communicate and meet frequently with students, parents/guardians to monitor performance;
4. Communicate and meet frequently with SDoP partner school teachers and counselors;
5. Manage student transportation from SDoP partner school in tandem with program staff;
6. Recruit local professionals, college students and community members to serve as volunteer tutors;
7. Record daily student evaluation in the areas of attendance, behavior, progress and performance;

8. Manage high school placement through the existing network of public and private school partners;
9. Organize enrichment outings as needed including cultural events, performances, museum trips;
10. Explore partnerships with area educational and cultural institutions as needed to enhance programming;

Assist With The Following:

1. Program-wide recruitment, retention and relations with all students and alumni;
2. Providing information relevant to academic-focused grant applications;
3. Preparation of academic reports and updates for website, email and other printed materials;
4. Organization of academic summer enrichment opportunities;
5. Assistance with special networking and fundraising events;
6. Assistance with chaperoning non-academic events (tournaments, service events, etc)

Additional Job Requirements:

1. Extensive knowledge of and experience with Microsoft Office required;
2. Must be an experienced driver with valid U.S. driver's license;
3. Must pass a state and federal criminal background screening;
4. Must be physically capable of standing/sitting/moving for extended periods of time; tasks (lifting, exercising, coaching, tutoring, driving, etc.);
5. Non-U.S. citizen applicants must hold appropriate working papers valid for at least two years.
